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RIDER

As part of and in addition to agreements made by Performance Contract, the Event Organization (employer) shall be responsible for providing the following:

- ◆ *Spring water for all musicians on stage.*
- ◆ *Non-smoking accommodations for the duration of the Event, if applicable, and accommodations necessary to facilitate the travel itineraries of the musicians. Crowfoot requires one single room and one double occupancy room in a quiet location away from any area where after hours activities may occur.*
- ◆ *Meals (or meal allowances) for the duration of the Event. Substantial vegetarian options, which do not rely heavily on soy or dairy, must be available.*
- ◆ *An area / table from which to sell recordings. Crowfoot shall be responsible for staffing the table and keep 100% revenue from sales unless otherwise agreed in advance.*
- ◆ *A designated parking space convenient to the performance stage, if applicable.*

The Event Organization is responsible for conveying the following information to the hired sound tech and other staff whom it may concern:

- ◆ *Current technical information is available on www.crowfootmusic.com; see: Press Kit, and select the "Tech Info" PDF appropriate to the Event.*
- ◆ *Both the Sound Technician for the Event and Crowfoot shall be present and prepared at a mutually agreed upon time to complete a thorough sound check of all instruments to be played by Crowfoot during the Event. The stage plot, as outlined in the above mentioned tech sheet, shall be set up in advance so as to facilitate a comprehensive and timely sound check. A minimum time of 1 hour shall be allotted to perform a sound check prior to a concert; a minimum of 45 minutes shall be allotted to the sound check before a dance event.*
- ◆ *Crowfoot requires enough time to clear the stage of all instruments and equipment belonging to Crowfoot before hired or volunteer staff disassemble the sound system and/or festive decorations on, and in close proximity to, the stage at the end of the Event. Crowfoot agrees to clear the stage as swiftly as possible during this period so as not to impact staff duties unnecessarily.*
